The Ocean CourseSM is nestled along the Atlantic Coastline in a primary-residence club community located 20 minutes south of historical St. Augustine and just north of Daytona Beach in Palm Coast, Florida.

SETTING:

Located on 2 miles of pristine Atlantic Coastline, Hammock Beach Resort is an innovatively designed resort/residential community that features varied accommodations ranging from luxurious condominiums and spacious villas to intimate suites in a boutique hotel on the beach. World-class amenities include a 36 holes of Signature golf, dining, shopping, tennis facility overlooking the Intracoastal Waterway, meeting and conference facilities, state of the art fitness center, 10,000 square-foot spa indoor aquatic center and a 6.5-acre multiple-level pool complex.

COURSE DESCRIPTION:

The Ocean CourseSM, a Jack Nicklaus Signature design, is Florida's first oceanfront course since the 1920's and offers a perfect blend of fun and challenge for players of all levels. Referred to as "The Pebble Beach of the East Coast", the Ocean Course is one of Nicklaus' most challenging designs and boasts six holes overlooking the ocean, including a magnificent 468-yard, par 4 finishing hole that is truly breathtaking. Nicklaus has also dubbed the final four holes here as the Bear's Claw, and they are considered to be among the world's most memorable finishing holes.

TYPE OF COURSE:

The Ocean CourseSM is a private resort course, open to members, their guests and resort guests. The green fee for resort guests ranges according to season and includes their cart. Club and shoe rentals are available per request.

COURSE ARCHITECT:

PGA Tour player Jack Nicklaus, an 18-time major championship winner, is the architect. Despite being extremely prolific, Nicklaus remains one of the most hands-on designers around.

UNIQUE CHARACTERISTICS:

A Jack Nicklaus Signature Design, the Ocean Course has 6 golf holes that border the ocean, the most in Florida. The course encompasses 100 acres of playable turf. The signature holes are the final 4 finishing holes described as the bear's claw. This difficult stretch of holes, bordering the ocean, will make it challenging to finish out a good round of golf

AMENITIES:

EXGO golf cars equipped with the GPS yardage system and Titleist AP 1 rental clubs are available. The golf club also provides complimentary valet parking and bag handling as well as PGA Professional Golf Staff available for lessons and clinics. The Ocean Course clubhouse at The Lodge features a full-service golf shop, relaxed restaurant and inviting bar, beautiful guestrooms, spacious locker rooms and views of the Atlantic Ocean and the eighteenth hole.

TEE SETTINGS:

Five sets of tees ranging from 5,115 to 7,201 yards.

PAR & YARDAGE:

Par 72 from Black: 7,201, Gold: 6723, Blue: 6,371, White: 5,811, Red: 5,115

GREENS:

Tifdwarf, a hybrid Bermudagrass that offers a surface similar to Bentgrass greens. TifEagle is the grass of choice for the fairways, tees, and roughs.

PRACTICE FACILITIES:

A dual-ended complex with large teeing areas designed to furnish continuous fresh grass. A 10,000 square-foot practice putting green, chipping green is also included
