The Legacy CourseSM at Reunion[®] Resort is situated on a 2,300-acre former citrus grove in Osceola County on County Road 545 (exit 58 on Interstate 4), immediately south of Disney's Town of Celebration, 20 minutes south of Orlando, 15 minutes from Walt Disney World[®] and 25 minutes from Orlando International Airport.

SETTING

The multi-faceted Reunion[®] Resort is an innovatively designed resort/residential community that features varied accommodations ranging from single- and multi-family homes to condominiums and townhomes, as well as amenities including 54 holes of Signature golf, dining, shopping, boutique spa, tennis centre, meeting and conference facilities, biking and walking trails and a five-acre Water Park complete with 1000 foot lazy river and 150 foot slide.

COURSE DESCRIPTION

Highlighted by expansive waste areas, strategically placed bunkers, spacious, closely mown green complexes and generously wide fairways, the Legacy CourseSM at Reunion[®] Resort is destined to become one of the nation's finest resort courses. Utilizing a combination of natural rolling terrain with mature trees, pristine natural preserve areas and extensive landscaping, the Legacy is challenging and beautiful. For Arnold Palmer fans, the short, par 4, 7th hole, which measures 303 yards for the championship tees and 274 yards from the member tees, is a vintage Arnie "go for broke," risk/reward hole that will excite low and high-handicappers.

TYPE OF COURSE

Legacy is a private Resort course, open to members, their guests and Resort guests. The green fee for resort guests ranges according to season and includes their cart fee. Club and shoe rentals are available per request.

COURSE ARCHITECT

The course designer is PGA Tour icon Arnold Palmer, whose success in golf course design has paralleled his prolific playing career. Palmer, with the expertise of partner Ed Seay, a past president of the American Society of Golf Course Architects, formed the Palmer Design Company in 1979. The Ponte Vedra Beach, Florida-based firm has been involved in more than 350 projects worldwide, with more than 150 golf courses open for play in 36 states and 20 countries.

UNIQUE CHARACTERISTICS

- The Legacy Course has a wide-open feel because almost all housing is built solely on the perimeter of the course instead of the interior.
- Landscaping on the Legacy CourseSM, includes 15 varieties of native grasses, azaleas and camellias.
- The course features one of the world's best drainage systems with more than 80,000 linear feet of drainage pipe.
- Wildlife on the property include coyote, fox, raccoon, Florida deer, gopher tortoise and armadillo.
- Birdlife on the property include wild turkey, heron, egret, osprey, red tail hawk and owl.
- Natural treelife on the course includes pine, palm, live oak, cypress, crepe myrtle and magnolia.
- More than 275 trees were carefully moved and re-planted on the Legacy Course.

AMENITIES

Golf carts equipped with the GPS yardage system and rental clubs are available.

TEE SETTINGS:

Five sets of tees ranging from 4,802 to 6,916 yards.

PAR & YARDAGE:

Par 72 from Black/Championship tees; 6,916, Gold 6,419; Blue 6,058; White 5,529; Red 4,802.

GREENS:

TifEagle, a hybrid Bermudagrass that offers a surface similar to Bentgrass greens. 419 Bermuda on approaches, tees, rough and green complexes.

PRACTICE FACILITIES:

Reunion[®] Resort has a five-acre duel-ended complex with large teeing areas designed to furnish continuous fresh grass. Additional facilities include chipping, putting and bunker practice areas.
