

The Salamander Collection

Grand Golf Resorts of Florida

Three of Florida's grandest golf resorts have recently united under the management of Salamander Hotels & Resorts. The Grand Golf Resorts of Florida features Innisbrook Resort near Tampa, Reunion Resort in Orlando, and Hammock Beach Resort in Palm Coast. The collection offers 162 holes of golf designed by Jack Nicklaus, Arnold Palmer, Tom Watson and Larry Packard – all of which are part of the Legends of Golf Trail, which traverses 200 miles between the resorts and across the Sunshine State.



Innisbrook Resort

Celebrating 40 years of excellence, Innisbrook Resort is situated on 900 wooded acres of rolling hills in the St. Petersburg/Clearwater area on Florida's Gulf Coast, and is located just 25 minutes from Tampa International Airport. Recently and completely renovated, the resort features four courses of championship golf designed by Larry Packard, 600 spacious guest suites and rooms, four restaurants and

three bars, the Innisbrook Golf Academy, 11 tennis courts, the new luxury Indaba Spa with 12 treatment rooms and state-of-the-art fitness center, six heated swimming pool complexes, a nature preserve, and three conference halls with 65,000 square feet of meeting space. The resort hosts the PGA TOUR Transitions Championship at its famed Copperhead Course, and the LPGA-supported Legends Tour Open Championship, held annually at the equally challenging Island Course.



Reunion Resort

Located in Orlando, the AAA Four Diamond-rated Reunion Resort features 330 accommodations, including luxury condominiums, private villas and deluxe vacation homes surrounded by 2,300 acres of lush landscape and nature preserve. Accommodations are highlighted by the 82-suite Reunion Grande, an 11-story hotel, replete with stunning lobby and bar, exquisite décor, elegantly appointed meeting space, and two

restaurants – including the hip Eleven, which features a rooftop pool and nightly views of the fireworks from nearby Walt Disney World. The resort is the only location in the United States with golf courses designed by golf greats Jack Nicklaus, Arnold Palmer and Tom Watson, and also features the exclusive ANNIKA Academy by Annika Sorenstam. Additional facilities include a boutique spa, multiple pools, slides, water playgrounds and a 1,000-foot lazy river.



Hammock Beach Resort

Located along 2.4 miles of spectacular Atlantic beach on Florida's Palm Coast, the AAA Four Diamond-rated Hammock Beach Resort features 320 accommodations, including a 12-story tower of ocean view luxury suites, and an intimate 20-room lodge that features spectacular ocean- and golf course views. Hammock Beach is famed for its two spectacular golf courses. The Ocean Course, designed by Jack

Nicklaus, is one of Florida's highest rated and plays six holes directly along the Atlantic Ocean. The Conservatory Course was designed by Tom Watson and is one of Florida's longest layouts, characterized by waterfalls, babbling brooks and field stone work. The resort also features countless amenities for families and groups, including a multi-level water and swim pavilion, indoor atrium pool, spa and fitness center, oceanfront meeting and function space, and numerous dining choices including the oceanfront Atlantic Grille restaurant.

Grand Resorts at Cap Cana

The Grand Resorts at Cap Cana collection includes the luxurious oceanfront Sanctuary resort, the brand-new, village-style Fishing Lodge and the to-be-completed Ocean Club boutique hotel (2013). Together, they offer the Caribbean's most attractive new destination – all only 10 minutes from Punta Cana International Airport, served by 38 airlines offering flights from 100 cities worldwide. Guests also enjoy a Jack Nicklaus Signature experience at the exclusive Punta Espada Golf Club – the top-ranked golf course in the Caribbean and Mexico.



Sanctuary Cap Cana

Developed at a cost of \$110 million dollars and featuring architectural designs that reflect both Caribbean and European influences, the Sanctuary features beautiful suites and villas with ocean views and swim-out access, five restaurants and bars, five pools, a lavish spa, and 18,000 square feet of meeting space. The resort's luxurious and

spacious accommodations range from 650 to 5,500 square feet, while many include expansive ocean views, secluded beach access or even their own private islands. Sanctuary Cap Cana provides a number of memorable dining options, all of which will open to the public, including the stunning Blue Marlin restaurant. Perched above the Caribbean Sea on stilts, it offers the area's finest seafood and most romantic location.



Fishing Lodge Cap Cana

Fishing Lodge, named for the Caribbean's largest inland marina which the resort surrounds, is located within a masterfully designed village. It features an array of amenities, including two themed restaurants, three bars, four pools, a 16th century-style stone wedding chapel, a state-of-the-art fitness center, boutique shops, and 30,000 square feet of event spaces, including a spectacular outdoor

amphitheater. There are 298 spacious, Mediterranean-style villas with stunning marina views, designer furnishings and innovative architecture. Built on low-rise docks, they range in size from junior to three-bedroom villas, while several feature private infinity pools and swim-out access.



Salamander Resort & Spa

Set on 340 acres in the foothills of the Blue Ridge Mountains amid Virginia's famed horse country and lush vineyards, yet only a 35-minute drive from Washington, D.C.'s Dulles Airport, Salamander Resort & Spa is currently under construction. Designed to blend into the natural environment in which it sits, the resort features 168 luxurious rooms and suites, a 23,000 square foot

luxury spa, a full service equestrian center, Virginia Piedmont-inspired dining, a dedicated cooking studio, wine bar and a unique array of conference and banquet facilities. The Resort is registered for LEED certification. Salamander Hotels & Resorts has master-planned a unique high-end mixed-use development which includes commercial office and retail, single-family homes and apartments.



Woodlands Inn

Located in the charming village of Summerville and just a short drive from historic Charleston, South Carolina, Woodlands Inn is an immaculately restored 1906 classic revival mansion set amidst 42 acres of parkland grounds. Recently refurbished, it is one of only six properties in North America to hold the Forbes Five-Star and AAA Five Diamond ratings for both its accommodations and dining

room. The Inn features 18 guest rooms and suites, a country guest cottage, a day spa, croquet lawn, red-clay tennis courts, a temperature-controlled swimming pool, unique meeting facilities and golf privileges at nearby area courses. The Dining Room at Woodlands is widely known for its innovative and sophisticated version of New American Cuisine.
