AileyCamp teaches discipline, inspires creativity in young dancers

The Berkeley/Oakland AileyCamp at Cal Performances is a six-week intensive dance camp designed to teach discipline and inspire creativity through dance to middle school children (ages 11-14) of Oakland. The camp raises \$250,000 annually in order to provide full scholarships to all of its campers, which includes lessons, uniforms, field trips, transportation, and two meals a day. This summer marks the 10th anniversary of AileyCamp in Berkeley/Oakland and so Director David McCauley chose "Transitions" as the theme for this year's performance. The theme highlights the transformation the campers have made in a short span of time, as well as celebrates their achievement as young dancers.
