There are several technical features that offer important performance benefits in this new design.



THE FLEX SYSTEM

This innovative technology reduces impact force transfer to the athlete by selectively adding flexibility to key SpeedFlex helmet components. Flex is engineered into the helmet's shell, face mask and its attachment system. Features of this system are found on a previous helmet, Riddell 360, and were enhanced on the SpeedFlex.

COMPOSITE ENERGY MANAGEMENT MATERIALS

Padding materials distributed throughout the inside of the helmet absorb impact energy, and retain their position and purpose over extended durations of play.

HELMET RETENTION SYSTEM

A new ratchet-style chinstrap attachment system developed based on elite player feedback and designed for easy, efficient adjustments that can keep up with the game's faster pace and offer a new way to help secure proper fit each play.

TRU-CURVE LINER SYSTEM

New interior liner that conforms to the shape of a player's head as well as fits the contours of the helmet shell (crown, back/side, occipital lock, faceframe) for improved comfort and fit.

LINER ATTACHMENT SYSTEM

Removable padding system designed for ease-of-use for equipment managers helps alleviate issues when switching pads.
